

ULTRA COMPACT, QUIET AND EASY TO CONTROL

This compact, portable projector weighs only 2.8 kg and has a small A4+ footprint. Operation is quiet, just 36db in quiet mode, so there is no distraction. Plus the LV-X4 is exceptionally easy to set up and use. A range of features can be selected automatically from the remote control, for push-button simplicity. You're always in charge, as a Key Lock function disables the keys on the projector's control panel or remote control.

Plus there's a laser pointer, on-screen pointer or spotlight function to draw attention to specific areas on the screen.






HIGHLY FLEXIBLE PROJECTOR PLACEMENT

Projecting in crowded classroom conditions can cause problems. That's where the LV-X4 makes all the difference. Canon's wide angle lens allows a large image to be projected even from a short distance. For added flexibility, a 1.6x zoom ratio offers an optimum image size from a remarkably wide range of throw distances. This includes perfect projection on a large 100-inch screen from just 2.5 meters right up to 4.0 metres. Also, Vertical Keystone Correction rectifies any image distortion if the projector is slightly tilted from the screen.

ADVANCED MULTIMEDIA CONNECTIVITY

Connect multimedia hardware to the LV-X4 with ease. The analogue RGB port can be used for input as well as output signals, allowing the projector to be hooked up to an external monitor such as a desktop PC screen. An optional SCART Connector, or optional Component Adapter, allows easy connection to a wide range of equipment from different manufacturers. This includes VCRs, DVD players, HDTV, digital camcorders and even game consoles.


